





Our visit to the Kingston Steam Plant

If you missed the visit to the TVA Kingston Steam Plant last Friday, it was a good one. Here are a few notes I made during the tour:

- It takes an entire train-load of coal, 110 cars, per day to feed this steam plant's nine units. They consume about 800 tons of coal per hour.
- There are more than three miles of conveyor belts to move coal around the plant. There are more than 100 miles of boiler tubes in the plant.
- Because of the extensive pollution control equipment that Kingston now has, they can burn a very low quality coal which is cheaper to buy. It comes from Wyoming and Illinois currently. Being able to utilize cheaper coal helps to keep our energy rates low.
- Our local coal is of a very high quality and is purchased by facilities in and out of the US that do not have good pollution control equipment and therefore need coal that is cleaner-burning. It is very expensive to buy.
- It takes all the power generated by one of the nine units to power all the pollution control equipment at the plant that handles both the stack emissions and the ash.
- The only materials exiting the stack are steam and CO2. The ash is all dried and sold as gypsum and concrete additive.
- The vessels/chambers where the burning takes place are actually suspended from above, not built up from below. This is because the burn chambers expand and elongate downward by as much as 18 inches as they heat up.



AHMP Chapter Presidents and Vice Presidents: We are fast-approaching the halfway point of 2018, and final details are coming together for what should be a great National Conference in Reno in late August! The always-popular Emergency Response Scenario, two unique tours, and four dozen technical sessions all are set, and three keynote speakers soon will be announced. We hope that 100% of our network of chapters will be represented at the Reno event with at least one delegate. Again this year, AHMP is offering a special rate to one designated individual per chapter: \$325, which includes a full day of training and peer interaction for chapter leaders AND registration to the full conference (Sunday to Wednesday). This is more than 50% off the regular member registration fee, and a discount of two-thirds off the nonmember rate. Some, if not many, chapters opt to cover this fee for their delegate as an expression of thanks for the individual's leadership commitment. Whether your chapter chooses to do this or not, the important thing is that your chapter be represented in Reno so that your leader(s) can learn from and share ideas with others from around the country. And while we obviously prefer that the chapter delegates all be current AHMP national members, this is not a requirement - your designee can be a chapter-only member if you wish. Here's what you need to do: At your earliest convenience, but no later than June 25th please, tell us who your chapter's delegate will be. We then will provide that individual with a discount code to use when registering for the conference to ensure that they receive the \$325 fee. And if your chapter will not, unfortunately, be able to send a delegate, we want to know that also. One other thing on the National Conference . . . As was offered last year, AHMP again is providing free booth space for chapters in the exhibit hall. This will be a shared booth, and chapters that want to participate will be able to staff the booth at designated times to promote the programs and services they offer to professionals in their geographic region.
